

Home to School Agreement 2024 - 2025

We are a Rights Respecting School and we all acknowledge that all have the same rights and responsibilities.

1. School

- Provide a balanced curriculum that meets the needs of your child.
- Care for your child's safety and wellbeing by providing a safe, secure, healthy and creative environment.
- Help and encourage your child to achieve their full potential.
- Prepare your child with the skills and confidence they need to succeed.
- Let home know of any concerns relating to your child.
- Keep home informed about general school matters, the curriculum and your child's progress.
- Encourage high standards of behaviour through developing good relationships and a sense of responsibility.
- Provide a Christian ethos.
- Celebrate your child's personal and academic achievements.
- Teach your child to develop a positive attitude to one another, regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values, age and need.
- Encourage your child to become an active member within our community and help them to see that they can have an impact on the world around them.
- Make you feel welcome whenever you visit the school and respond to your questions or concerns as quickly as possible.
- Provide online work when the class are unable to come into school (e.g.covid times)

2. Home

- My/our child attends school and provides a note of explanation if they are absent.
- The school is informed of any concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's behaviour or work.
- My/our child arrives on time, ready to learn and is collected on time.
- My/our child is dressed in school uniform and properly equipped for subjects such as PE. If their hair is shoulder length or longer it must be tied back at all times.
- Encourage and support my/our child with learning key facts (such as spelling rules and times tables and listening to them read) and encourage them to take part in online learning.
- Wherever possible I/we will attend parents' evenings and discussions about my/our child's progress.
- Read all information sent home as this gives me important details of relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.
- Support school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home.
- Support school policies (e.g. behaviour and anti-bullying, homework, safeguarding).



3. **Pupils**

- Arrive on time and ready to learn.
- Always try to do my best in my lessons and ask questions if I don't understand.
- Learn key facts (such as spelling rules and times tables and read at home).
- Listen and not distract others from their learning.
- Respect other children's culture, race, feelings, beliefs and values.
- Be kind, helpful and forgiving and speak politely to everyone in school.
- Take good care of the building, equipment and school grounds.
- Tell a member of staff if I am worried or unhappy.
- Be respectful towards others and behave in a safe and responsible way.
- Be honest.
- Use the Internet safely as I have been taught in class.
