Phonics Meeting

There will be a short meeting for year 1 Year 2 parents regarding phonics and spellings for the children in the coming year. You will have an opportunity to see some of the resources we will be using during their lessons and giving you some ideas on how to support your child with phonics and spellings. There will also be an opportunity to see what the Year One Phonics test looks like for the end of the year.
